Attention all Adelaide media professionals

Nominations for the 18th Archbishop of Adelaide Annual Media Citations are now open.

The awards have a reputation for credibility and recognising professional excellence and social benefit.

The awards are not intended to focus on publicity given to the Catholic Church or religion generally. They seek to recognise reporting which shows a commitment to truth, balance, fairness and community service.

The awards will also consider equity – the limited resources which may be available to an individual or newsroom in producing strong work.

Nominations should be in the following categories: a major news story, a series of articles, a piece of investigative reporting, an opinion piece or feature, a photograph or any TV, radio or Internet work which deserves recognition. The work can be by an individual or team (reporter, producer, cameraman, editor, photographer, sound engineer or anyone working in the media).

Individuals may nominate their own work or the work of others they wish to see rewarded. There is a limit of three entries per person.

The work must be locally produced, published or broadcast during the period from April 1, 2007, to March 31, 2008.

Please send your nomination in the form of a letter, with a tape, video, photocopy or web address of the nominated work by close of business on Friday, April 11, 2008 to:
